# Outcome of the First Call for Proposals

- Number of applications received: 122
- Number of projects approved: 11
- Countries covered: Burkina Faso (2), Cameroon (1), Chad (2), Ghana (2), Mali (1), Mauritania (1), Senegal (2)
- Total Budget allocated: 6,5 million €
- Budget per project: max. 600 000 €
- Average duration of projects: 28 months
- Number of Partners: 50 => 24 European partners, 26 African partners
